HUDSON COUNTY CLERK E. JUNIOR MALDONADO 2020 GENERAL ELECTION UPDATE

Hudson County, NJ- In addition to the informational content found at the new and improved 2020 General Election Hudson County Voting Portal website (<https://vote2020.hcnj.us/>), the Portal now also features a web mapping application identifying all 107 polling locations for the upcoming election. It also includes the following:

- Ward and district boundaries, depicted in different colors for easy viewing;
- An interactive map which marks each polling location with an icon. The polling icons, when clicked on, show the address of the polling location along with the ward and district(s) that particular location represents; and
- A search function that allows users to enter an address in a search bar to quickly identify the district and polling location for that address.

Additionally, in order to get up-to-date voting information in one simple, safe and secure place, voters can visit the new and improved 2020 General Election Hudson County Voting Portal website at <https://vote2020.hcnj.us/>. This portal provides a wealth of information surrounding this year's very important election. Some of the website features include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Secure Ballot Drop Box Location Finder
- USPS Informed Delivery Service
- Polling Place Information
- Track Your Ballot Feature through the State Voter System

This site can also answer questions such as, "How can I vote by mail?" "How do I register to vote?" "What if I haven't received my ballot?" and "Can I vote in person?"

We understand that this General Election is taking place during a time of great uncertainty and stress. This portal will keep the constituents of Hudson County educated and informed in an effort to dispel any misinformation regarding the vote-by-mail process and procedures.
